Why This Matters

A new ADA Title II rule now requires all state and local governments – and any contractors or vendors providing digital services on their behalf – to have accessible websites and mobile apps that meet WCAG 2.1 AA accessibility standards.

Accessibility is no longer optional. Beginning as early as April 2026, it becomes a legal requirement, and ignoring it can lead to lawsuits or risks to funding.

If you are a government organization or you provide government-sponsored services – including non-profit organizations – this ruling affects you.
